



TEXAS PLANT PROTECTION ASSOCIATION 2009 Agricultural Scholarship Program Guidelines

The Texas Plant Protection Association (TPPA) is interested in continuing the development of a relationship with students and Texas A&M University by providing scholarships to eligible students. The purpose of these scholarships is to encourage students to pursue a degree in the agricultural sciences which will hopefully lead to a career in some field in agriculture. This year, two \$1000 scholarships will be offered to eligible students. These scholarships are for the 2010 Fall semester only. This scholarship program will be provided by the TPPA as long as funds are sufficient to maintain this program as directed by the Board of Directors of this organization. The selection of the scholarship recipients are the responsibility of the scholarship committee of the Association and final approval will be by the Board of Directors of TPPA.

Requirements for applicants:

- * All applicants must be full-time undergraduates (12 hrs minimum) in the TAMU College of Agriculture and Life Sciences and have a minimum of 30 hours toward their degree program.
- * Demonstrate leadership skills and involvement in extra-curricular activities.
- * Priority will be given to students without other scholarships
- * A student may re-apply for the scholarship each year.
- * Previous award winners do not have an advantage over other applicants
- * All scholarship winners must be in good standing with the university.

Award winners will be required to present a 5 to 10 minute discussion on themselves and their undergraduate program at the annual meeting of the Texas Plant Protection Association which is held in early December in College Station.
